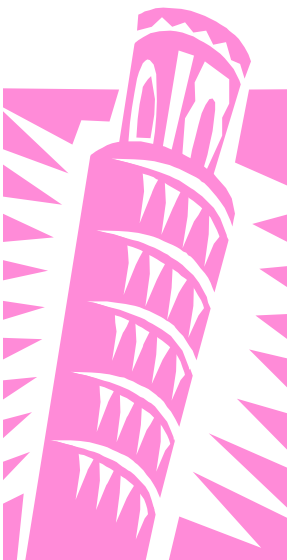


Spelling: ys and ies

★ If there is a vowel before the final y of a word, you just add s. eg storey becomes storeys

★ If there is a consonant before the final y of a word, knock off the y and add ies.
eg story becomes stories
